# About the Workshop

This workshop begins with an overview of the presenter's recent book, A Roadmap for Couple Therapy: An Integration of Systemic, Psychodynamic, and Behavioral Approaches, describing the main approaches to couple therapy and showing how to combine them. The presenter then uses case material to examine psychodynamic approaches to couple therapy in greater detail.

# Learning Objectives

- 1. Participants will be able to list at least 3 categories of couple therapy interventions—based on systems theory, psychodynamics and relationship education—that have been shown effective individually in past research and clinical work.
- 2. Participants will list 3 ways to sequence these categories of interventions.

#### THE PRESENTER

#### Arthur Nielson, M.D.

Arthur Nielsen, M.D. is a full-time, practicing psychiatrist, psychoanalyst and couple therapist. He is a Clinical Associate Professor of Psychiatry at Northwestern's Feinberg School of Medicine, a faculty member at Northwestern's Family Institute in Evanston, and a faculty member of the Chicago Institute for Psychoanalysis where he has taught courses in severe personality disorders, psychoanalytic research and, relevant to this talk, couple therapy. For many years and until recently, he was the coordinator of a for credit course he developed for Northwestern undergraduates, "Marriage 101: Building Loving and Lasting Relationships." He is the author of thirty-some published professional papers in the fields of psychiatry, psychoanalysis, and couple therapy. His recent textbook, *A Roadmap for Couple Therapy: Integrating Systemic, Psychodynamic, and Behavioral Approaches*, forms the backbone for this talk.
