

Perplexing Problems in Psychological Practice: Decision Science, Ethics & Risk Management scheduled for Friday April 17, 2020 from in-person to **LIVE STREAM**

Based on evolving circumstances surrounding the COVID-19 outbreak, and a commitment to public health, the Illinois Psychological Association has decided to adapt the in-person **Perplexing Problems in Psychological Practice: Decision Science, Ethics & Risk Management scheduled for Friday April 17, 2020 from in-person to **LIVE STREAM** on the Zoom platform.**

Understanding of the potential reach of the virus is constantly evolving, which makes real risk assessment complicated. IPA has been staying on top of the reports from federal and local officials and monitoring the science. Because the health and safety of our members and partners is paramount, we believe the wisest course of action is to adapt to the virtual platform.

We recognize how hard people work to attend in person and understand the disappointment of receiving this news, however, we will keep the same date and time to allow for all registrants to attend.

Some things to note:

- If you are not comfortable with using Zoom, IPA is trying set up a practice link, stayed tuned.

- The workshop will be interactive with live Q&A throughout. It will be the same length of time and cover the same learning objectives and material.

All applications are individually underwritten, and submission of CE certification will not guarantee insurance policy issuance or renewal.
